2nd grade Homework

Here is a list of expected homework in 2nd grade.



Reading (15 minutes daily)

A reading story will be given on Monday. Students need to read the story to an adult at least once. The adult needs to sign their names and then the student needs to return the homework by <u>Wednesday</u>. If the student does not have the signed copy returned on time then the student will stay in at recess to read the homework story.

*Please practice reading 15 minutes a night. This will help with reading fluency.

Math (3 minutes daily)

MMF (Mastering Math Facts) homework will be given on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. The student needs to practice saying the math problem out loud for 1 minute (timed). Example: "1 plus 3 is 4". Do this timed practice 3 times. The parent needs to sign the MMF homework each day. If the student does not bring the signed MMF homework sheet back each day then the student will miss 5 minutes of recess.

What can a student do if they forgot or lost their homework?

The main purpose of MMF homework is to practice math facts. So if a student cannot find their homework, there are a couple of different ways to practice. *A student can practice math flashcards.

*MMf flashcards are on the D.C. West website.

*An adult or student can write down and answer 40 math facts that go along with their MMF facts.

An adult needs to write me a note stating that their child practiced their math facts.

Spelling (5-10 minutes daily)

Spelling words will be handed out on Friday. The Spelling test will be given on the following Thursday. Please practice daily.
