

Mineral Info Card

- 1) Choose a mineral for your card. You can find a list of minerals on my Earth Science Web Sites page.
- 2) Make sure you **have a picture or pictures of your mineral** on one page of the paper along with the name of the mineral and your name.
- 3) On the backside of the paper you should have **at least 20 facts** about your mineral. The following must be included:
 - Color or colors the mineral is found in.
 - Hardness
 - Luster
 - Density
 - Streak color
 - Cleavage or Fracture
 - Crystal Structure
 - Any unique properties your mineral has
 - Uses and or interesting facts
 - Where it is found and /or mined
 - Any facts on how they mine or collect it
- 4) **The content is very important.** Make sure you do a great job of getting facts with good information in them. Be descriptive and informational. Also, make sure you proofread your facts. Make sure you are rewording information. You cannot copy word for word what someone else has written.
- 5) **Use your class time well.** Use of time will be part of your grade.
