#### 7.2. Approve Certificated Staff Additions for the 2020-2021 School year

As scheduling for the 2020-2021 school year has been in the works, there are needs with shared staff in the arts and music departments that are necessary in order to serve all students. The administration recommended:

- .25 FTE Elementary Music ~ Kaitlin Beck, Part-time Elementary Music Teacher, would move to Full-time at the Elementary.
- .125 FTE Middle School Art~ Sean Pralle, High School Art Teacher, would add 8th grade Art to his schedule.

Staff have also reviewed the upcoming student caseloads for Special Education. Using a weighted formula, staff ratios needed have been determined. In order to serve students, it was recommended to add **1.0 FTE Special Education Teacher** in the Elementary School for the 2020-2021 school year.

The budget need for these additions is approximately \$70,000.
