A Traditional 8-period day for all 6th/7th/8th Grade Middle School Students.

A Homeroom setting for our 6th grade students with daily transitions every 45 minutes. Students daily schedule will include the following: Reading, Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies, Pride/Guided Study Hall, Physical Education, Band/Choir, and Specials.

Pride/Guided Study Hall: Daily Academic Advisory Program for all 6th/7th/8th grade students for 30 minutes after lunch (10 minutes-Pride, 20 minutes-Guided Study Hall). There are weekly Pride Focus Topics to be discussed throughout the year.

- H.A.L. (High Ability Learning) Monthly Rotation in Math, Reading/LA, and Science
- M.T.S.S. (Multi-Tiered Systems of Support) Individual and Small Group
- E.L.L. (English Language Learners)
- Guided Study Halls (Provide extra Academic Support)
- Falcons Nest (After School Guided Study Hall)
- Specials Classes:
 - o 8th Grade: (6 offerings and students participate in 4 that rotate every 9 weeks) Intro to French (all students take), Intro to Spanish, Family & Consumer Science, Information Technology, Strength & Conditioning, and Art.
 - o 7th Grade: (6 offerings that rotate every 6 weeks) STEM, Media Research, Theatre, Art, Computers, and Careers.
 - o 6th Grade: (6 offerings that rotate every 6 weeks) STEM, Media Research, Theatre, Art, Computers, and Health.



A variety of Extra-Curricular Opportunities in Athletics, Fine Arts, and Activities.

Falcon Flyers: Daily student recognition for students modeling The Falcon Way. One name from each grade will be drawn daily.

Above and Beyond: Weekly recognition to students that receive a Falcon Gram from a staff member for displaying positive Above and Beyond behaviors.

Students of the Month: Monthly students are nominated by their teachers and fellow classmates for displaying The Falcon Way characteristics that are worthy of being named a student of the month. One boy and one girl from each grade level will be selected.

Falcon Rewards: A Quarterly student incentive program celebrating students that have no failing grades, no written principal referrals, and no missing assignments for the quarter.

Awesome Attendance Raffle: Quarterly student incentive, rewarding students with great attendance throughout the quarter. Any student with two absences or less will enter a raffle. There will be two names drawn from each grade level totaling six students that get to choose an item for lunch. The choices are a large pizza, a dozen donuts, a large blizzard, or a fast food meal. Please still remember that if you are displaying signs of illness to stay home for the day and get to feeling better.
