  - Hoping with increased membership and fundraising money we can expand our support to ALL NSAA sports and activities at DCW.
  - Vote was made to move this to the 2024-2025 school year.
- Sponsor Basketball Team Tournament at Sokol ? \*\*Discussed in Executive Session
  - TerBeest made a request for a \$150 donation to the HS Basketball team to participate in a tournament at Sokol. Timmery made a motion to approve the donation of \$150. Motion was seconded by Jodie, all in favor.
- Senior Banners \*\*Discussed in Executive Session
  - In the past the Booster club has paid for the individual banners of each Senior HS student at DCW. These banners line the hallway of the school. Last year, due to financial shortages, the Booster Club wasn't able to provide these. TerBeest asked if we could reinstate?
  - Timmery made a motion to approve the funding for the cost of Sr. banners. Jessica 2nd, all in favor. Banners are approximately \$1185.00 for class of 2024
- Banquet- individual end of season team banquets
  - Timmery made a motion to approve \$200 per team to be used for end of season banquet/team supplies. Jodie 2nd, all approved. Coaches will be notified.
- Basketball Warm ups (Larissa Travis) \*\*Discussed in Executive session
  - Discussion was held about reimbursing varsity (boys) basketball parents for warm up pants that were purchased. The pants cost \$1,000-1200. Pants have already been purchased (varsity parents paid for 12 pairs, Coach Daehling paid for 3), they plan to donate back to the program after the season to be used for years to come. After much discussion and talk of covering a portion of the pants, discussion was tabled until after the meeting in an Executive Session. During the Executive Session it was decided to hold off on decision making until next month. We are still trying to develop our budget and want to be fair to all teams. We will have a better idea of our financial situation after our Cornhole Tournament and our Winter membership drive. Further discussion will take place at December meeting
